	Population: All general hospitals participating voluntarily in the P4P programme granting them a specific budget based on results of quality indicators				
Rationale	In 2015, the Belgian federal government and federated entities agreed on a joint plan to develop an integrated and people centred care system with a focus on people with chronic diseases. Since 2018, this plan has included the financing of various pilot projects around patient empowerment, carers' support, case management, concentration and coordination. The government is currently developing a new inter-federal plan for integrated care. This plan should become the driving force behind a transition widely supported by the various competent authorities and the care and welfare sectors.				
	Patient satisfaction is also increasingly taken into account in the financing of care in Belgium, in particular through the integration of patient-reported experience measures (PREMs) in the Pay for Performance (P4P) programme of hospitals (see below) based on existing initiatives of VIKZ (using the survey "Vlaamse PatiëntenPeiling" developed by VPP), BSM, PAQS (Plateforme pour l'Amélioration continue de la Qualité des soins et de la Sécurité des patients) and Santhea.				
	In P4P, quality is assessed by the authorities based on indicators regarding their structure, process and results (accreditation process, incident notification, patient-reported experience measurement, clinical processes and outcomes). In 2017–2018, 94% of hospitals participating in the P4P programme (96 out of 102) collected PREMs. ² Patient-reported outcome measures (PROMs) has not been measured for P4P purposes.				
	The P4P granting represents a limited part of the hospital's budget.				
Data source	Data on patient-reported experiences has been collected in P4P since 2018 from various partner organisations. These partners differ between the regions and encompass a different number of hospitals. All Flemish hospitals are partnered with the Vlaams Patiëntenplatform (VPP) for measuring patient experiences in line with the Vlaams Indicatorenproject (VIP²). In Wallonia and Brussels, hospitals collaborate with BSM, PAQS, Santhea for measuring patient experiences.				
Technical definitions	Because these different organizations use a variety of questionnaires and different scales to determine patient satisfaction, the percentage of positive responses was calculated to address some methodological differences. A positive experience score is defined for each scale as follows:				
	2-point scale: 2				
	3-point scale: 3				

4-point scale: 3 or higher5-point scale: 4 or higher10-point scale: 7 or higher

• 11-point scale: 8 or higher

Each hospital was required to collect a minimal number of questionnaires in order to obtain points in the P4P-program. Furthermore, for each P4P-program year, this minimal number could differ and was different for each service. It should also be noted that some hospitals, when not meeting the minimal number of required questionnaires, did not provide us with any information.

C/D service:

- 2018 minimum of 300 questionnaires
- 2019 minimum of 125 questionnaires
- 2020 minimum of 250 questionnaires
- 2021 minimum of 125 questionnaires
- 2022 minimum of 125 questionnaires

Maternity ward:

- 2021 minimum of 50 questionnaires
- 2022 minimum of 50 questionnaires

Day hospital:

2022 - minimum of 125 questionnaires

1.1.2 Results

Overall, the majority of the patients reported positive experiences in Belgian hospitals (91.5% positive score in 2022). The experience is better in maternity wards (97.7%) than in C/D beds (96.2%) and in day care (80.6%). The experience is more or less the same in Wallonia (92.1%) and Flanders (92.0%) but less positive in Brussels (86.7%)(Table 1).

In maternity wards, the frequency of the positive experience is quite similar by region but Brussels reported less positive experience in C/D beds and daycare than Flanders and Wallonia (Table 1).

It is difficult to assess the trend over time because the indicators (and the way in which they are measured) are different from one year to the next (Table 2), but we have observed a predominantly positive experience that has been maintained over the years (Table 1).

Keypoints

- Overall, the majority of the patients reported positive experiences in Belgian hospitals (91.5% positive score in 2022).
- The experience is better in maternity wards (97.7%) than in C/D beds (96.2%) and in day care (80.6%).
- The evolution of patient-reported experiences as reported in P4P over time showed a slight positive trend that has been maintained over the years, although there is a variability of results for the different included items.
